



Have we made a difference to cannulation technique?




Our change ideas did not work: why did they not work

- Measuring and recording stuff is a challenge
- Paperwork duplication
- Definitions of missed cannulation and categories of aneurysm became a bit distracting
 - Though all conversations on this are useful!
- Sonosite uptake appears variable with some people still lacking confidence
- Some fistulas are not big enough
- Some patients still don't want to expand their needling zones

Our change ideas worked: why did they work?

- Better understanding of what rope ladder is
- Better understanding of why it matters
- A common purpose and shared goal
- We took time to talk to each other



What project change ideas did we implement before COVID Pandemic?

- Implemented the fistula assessment tool in 8 units
 - Redesigned in one unit
- Fistula issues discussed in handover / huddle
 - Escalation more swiftly
 - Photos sent on Pando
- Sonosite use promoted
 - Notable reduction in anxiety for some patients
- Recirculation recorded each session
 - And used to trigger further investigations
- Engaged patients in more discussions
 - Posters helped

Our project plans for the next few months (COVID permitting)

- Share ideas across our units
- Single document for pre and post cannulation record
- Push e learning uptake
 - Test & trace / self isolation
- Get bottle tops into our bleed pack
- Standardise recirculation recording
- Build confidence with ultrasound
- Build confidence with buttonholing
